TUESDAY 8TH JULY | ANIMAL FUN DAY (SPLIT EXCURSIONS)

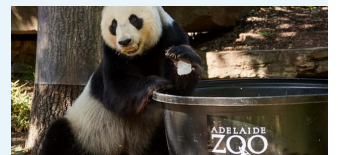
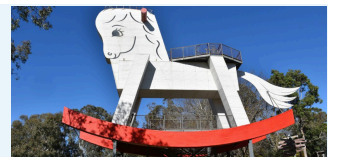
RECEPTION - YR 2: BIG ROCKING HORSE, WILDLIFE PARK AND MINI GOLF

MTOP 5.2: Children engage with a range of texts and gain meaning from these texts

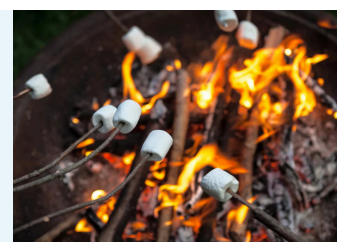


FRIDAY 11TH JULY | PJs AND CAMPING DAY (AT HOME DAY)

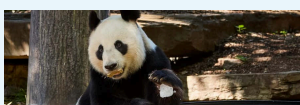

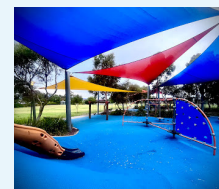

GENERAL EXCURSION DAY NOTES:

- **All students must arrive in school sports uniform attire, appropriate for the weather.** Students dressed inappropriately for forecast (e.g. shorts and T-shirt on a rainy/cold day) that presents a potential health risk may be sent home at the discretion of the Director or Assistant Director.
- **Please ensure your child(ren) have recess, lunch and a water bottle packed in a light carry bag.**
- **A sun-safe hat is implemented any time the UV is above a level 2.** If your child arrives without a hat, or their hat is not sun-safe, they will be required to remain in the shade for any outdoor activities.
- Children must arrive at a minimum 30 minutes prior to the scheduled departure time to be present for safety discussions and roll call prior to boarding the bus. We aim to start boarding 10 minutes prior to our departure time.
